

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Longdowns – Pedestrian Crossing Facilities

Cormac Solutions Ltd on behalf of Cornwall Council is inviting comments on a proposal to build a new section of footway and a new pedestrian crossing with a central refuge at Longdowns.

The new crossing will provide pedestrians with a safer method of crossing the road. Currently pedestrians are required to cross a wide stretch of road with two lanes. The new refuge will provide pedestrians with the option to cross one lane at a time, decreasing crossing time while improving safety. The new paved footway will prevent pedestrians from having to walk on the verge.
