LIFE'S BETTER AT 20 MPH

By 2030, we want to reduce both fatal and serious injury collisions by 50% on Cornish roads. In order to achieve this goal, one step we are taking is to reduce speeds from 30mph to 20mph in many areas.

20mph provides many safety, social and environmental benefits. Slower speeds help to encourage people in the community to walk and cycle, and feel safe to do so. In addition, the campaign will support Cornwall's ambition to be carbon neutral by 2030 by lowering congestion and emissions.

Benefits to communities include:

Making our streets safer. This will reduce casualties and make life better for the community

Providing a safe environment which will encourage more people to walk and cycle

Creating a stronger sense of community



Increasing child and adult activity levels, which will improve health and wellbeing

Supporting Cornwall's climate change declaration. This will include lower emissions and tackling congestion
